

# Symptoms of COVID-19


**Know the symptoms of COVID-19, which can include the following:**



**Cough, shortness of breath, or difficulty breathing**




**Congestion, sore throat, fever, or chills**



**Fatigue, headache, or body aches**



**Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea**



**New loss of taste or smell**

**If you are experiencing any of these symptoms, get tested for COVID-19.**

**Symptoms can range from mild to severe and appear 2–14 days after you are exposed to the virus that causes COVID-19.**

**Seek medical care immediately if you or someone you know has  
Emergency Warning Signs of COVID-19:**

- Trouble breathing
- Persistent pain or pressure in the chest
- New confusion
- Difficulty waking or staying awake
- Pale, gray, or blue-colored skin, lips, or nail beds, depending on skin tone
